GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 18+ years old
- 2.5 GPA or higher depending on home university requirement
- Sophomore status and/or required prerequisites
- Must be approved by home university to study abroad
- Valid passport or ability to obtain one
- Ability to obtain an Italian visa (non-US citizens)
- No Italian language requirement

PROGRAM COST

CIMBA has inclusive pricing with no hidden fees. Cost covers:

- Tuition (summer: 6 credits, semester: up to 18 credits)
- Housing in on-campus residence hall
- Meal package (3 meals daily)
- Textbook rental
- Laundry, linens, towels, and housekeeping
- Certificates and programs in leadership and personal development including one-on-one coaching (semester)
- Cultural exploration activities
- Company tours
